Setting up WordPress with Auto Installer on your domain or subdomain is a quick and easy process. It will take only a few minutes for you to have a running WordPress site.

Preparations

Before heading to the WordPress installation, make sure that:

- Your domain is pointing to Hostinger.
- The domain is added to your hosting plan.
- If you're installing WordPress on a subdomain, ensure the subdomain is created.

Step 1 - Open Auto Installer

On your panel, go to <u>Websites</u> \rightarrow **Dashboard**, search for **Auto Installer** in the left sidebar, and click on it.

- Administrator password create a strong password for your WordPress admin account.
